










<b>For children who need support with toilet training when starting nursery</b>	
<b>Pull ups please</b> Please provide them with pull ups and or pants (not nappies)	
<b>Clothing</b> <b>No</b> vests with poppers.	
These vests are okay.	
Trousers and other clothes must simple and easy to put on and take off. Leggings and jogging trousers are best.	
<b>Avoid</b> zips, buttons and belts, dresses and tights, skinny jeans that children cannot pull up and down easily.  Avoid clothing children cannot do easily by themselves.	
<b>Spare clothes</b> Please have two spare sets of clothes in a bag clearly labelled with their name on it. (You can just write the name on, in the inside of the bag.)	
<b>Shoes</b> It is best if shoes slip off and on easily. Simple lace up shoes/trainers are okay	



## What you can do to help?

Persist with toilet training when your child shows signs of being ready for toilet training.

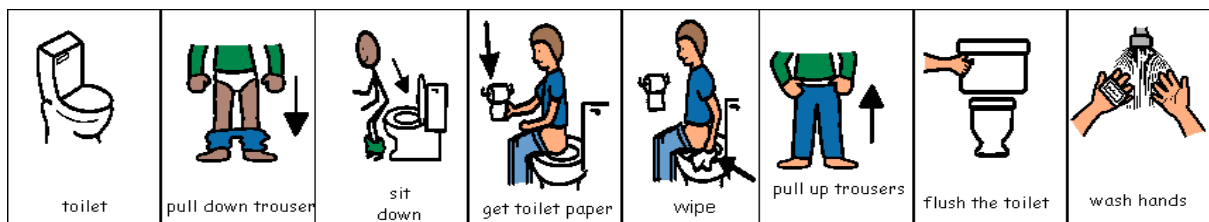
Work on your child being able to do socks, shoes and put their clothes on by themselves.

Attend coffee mornings/workshops on toilet training so that you can learn how to encourage and support toilet training.

Here is a visual we use in school to help toilet train children. Stick it up on the bathroom door to remind your child of the routine:



By helping your child achieve this skill, you will really help them move on in their development. They will feel very proud.

- Support you with toilet training in school but you must do it at home consistently too.
- Refer you to the children's centre for toileting support at home

We may call you to change your child if we do not have the clothing to change them.
